St Mary's High School partners with VHS Collaborative, which offers opportunities for online learning. Students will have access to approximately 300 courses it is a great opportunity to pursue interests and take electives you may not normally have the opportunity to take or to take a required course that just can't fit into your schedule. These classes are typically open to students in Grades 11 and 12, but exceptions can be made for underclassmen on a case by case basis. To be successful in one of these courses, students must be extremely self-disciplined, self-motivated, and be able to take full responsibility for their own time management.

Students may take no more than 2 VHS courses per year. The school will cover the cost of one course up to \$350. Any cost over and above this will be at the expense of the family. Any student taking a second course will be charged the full amount for that course. If a student decides to drop a VHS course or fails a VHS course, they will be required to reimburse the school for the cost of the course.

- VHS Students must:
 1. Have the approval from the Dean of Academics.
 2. Have the approval from a parent.
 3. Turn in the Student Policy Form signed by the student, parent, and Dean of Academics.
 4. Complete the VHS student orientation before the class begins.
 5. Complete the course's final exam if required.

By committing to this class, I will work diligently to make the most of the learning opportunity. I understand that if I choose to drop the course or fail the course, I will be required to reimburse the school for the cost of the course.
